Also included with each *Data Pamphlet* is selected comparative data for the U.S. and all Census Regions as well as rankings of the *Data Pamphlet* geographic area among similar areas for population, employment and income growth.

### **County Projections to 2060**

Woods & Poole county projections are updated annually and take into account specific local conditions based on historical data from 1969 to 2022; all data from 2023 to 2060 are projected. Although not an indicator of future accuracy, the average absolute percent error for Woods & Poole's 10-year total population projections has been  $\pm 8.1\%$ for counties and  $\pm 3.9\%$  for states.

Data Pamphlets are available by download in spreadsheet files for use in almost any spreadsheet software. These computer readable files make it easier for the user to analyze the data, prepare special tables, and create graphs and charts. The data files by download have **annual data** through 2060.
